STEP 1. FREE ONLINE ENERGY ASSESSMENT

Oconto Falls Municipal Utilities, in partnership with Focus on Energy, wants to help you use energy smarter. Focus on Energy is offering a FREE online energy assessment for all small business customers. Upon completing the assessment, you will receive a detailed action plan and summary of your energy savings opportunities. You will also be able to request a free energy savings pack, while supplies last.

STEP 2. MAIN STREET EFFICIENCY PROGRAM

We want to provide support to our “main street” business customers to help save energy. The goal of the Main Street Efficiency Program is to identify electric efficiency projects, and to provide limited-time bonus incentives to ensure projects get completed. Qualifying projects will help you control energy costs, while meeting minimum efficiency requirements.

STEP 3. SHARED SAVINGS PROGRAM

We're giving businesses the upfront capital needed to make qualifying energy-efficiency improvements – up to \$50,000 for up to 5 years. Repayments are made in regular installments on your monthly utility bill. And because your repayment plan is based entirely on the money the energy-efficient improvements will save, your utility bill will stay almost the same during the 5 year repayment.

Customers must receive pre-approval from Oconto Falls Municipal Utilities as part of the Main Street Efficiency Program or Shared Savings Program before a project commences to ensure available funding.
